- Freedom of access to information
- Preservation of data and records
- Authenticity (deep fake)

DUTCH ARCHIVES LAW 1995

- New design in 2020, new law in 2023
- What's new? Modernization, adjustment, not a revolution

KVAN, A NEW INFORMATION LAW

- Integration of several interests in different laws in to a new Information Law
- Acces to information (WOB, WOO, Archives Law)
- Privacy (GDPR)
- Security (BIO)

KVAN, A NEW INFORMATION LAW

- First phase; integration of information policy within government structures
- Cooperation between the Archivist, the CIO, security officers, information commissioners and privacy commissioners

THE NEW ARCHIVES LAW 2021

- Text is adjusted to digital society and modernized
- New transfer period; 10 years
- Restrictions in accessibility must be motivated by government agencies
- Government agencies are obliged to appoint an archivist in the organization
- There is no obligation anymore about a diploma/certificate
- For some organization an exemption is made about transferring there records

ALL-IN-ALL

- Old concepts have not changed (transfer, authenticity, appraisal, accessibility)
- No new answers to the modern challenges in record keeping (common grounds, datadriven business, duplication of information, platform technologies, authenticity and durability)
- Most important is 10 years tranfer period!
